The meeting was brought to order by President, Greg Bogus.
The minutes of May 1, 2026, meeting were approved unanimously.

I. Treasurer's Report: Gary Teale

A. Gary asked Jenny, Patty, and Diane to submit the hours they have accrued while working on the Meals On Wheels Summer Project and to continue submitting their hours on an ongoing basis.

B. How much should be charged for the admin hourly fee to The Stone Soup Account? Discussion followed. Gary moved that the fee should be \$75/hour. The motion passed with five yays and two nays.

C. There is \$2600 available for grants. One grant application is waiting for admin approval.

D. Gary shared with the board that there is gentleman that wants to fund an annual scholarship of \$10,000 to a female student in memory of his sister. The MTSS would determine who that student would be each year. Criterial would include overcoming obstacles and community work. There would be an additional base fee and hourly administrative fee in addition to the \$10K.

A. As of now, 20 students have signed up, and meal deliveries start on June 22nd and continue every Monday until August 17th.

B. Michael, who is a super senior, will be a volunteer and helping with this project.
